Section 1: The Board of Trustees of the Village of Mexico, Oswego County, New York, pursuant to the authority of subdivision 5 of the General Municipal Law, Section 3-c, and the vote of at least 60 percent of the members of the Board of Trustees, is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2016-2017 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the limit specified in General Municipal Law, Section 3-c.

Section 2: This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Department of State.
