ESTABLISHING NEW WATER RATES

Section 1: The following changes are hereby made relative to water charges.

A) The quarterly rate for water users inside the Village shall be increased from \$2.35 per 1000 gallons used to \$3.00 per 1000 gallons used per quarter, effective with the quarter ending May 31, 2019.

B) The quarterly rates for water users outside the Village limits, including water districts 1, 2 and 3 and the Town of New Haven and in any other district or area hereafter established outside the Village of Mexico limits is also set and fixed at \$3.00 per 1000 gallons used effective with the quarter ending May 31, 2019.

C) All water accounts inside or outside of the Village shall be in the name of the property owner even if the property is leased. Upon written request signed by the property and any tenant now existing or hereafter leasing premises, a courtesy duplicate bill shall be sent to the tenant who shall be subject to all rules and regulations of the Village relative to water use and cost.

D) All customers shall be given 30 days from date of billing to pay their water bills. Bills not paid within the 30 days shall include a penalty charge of 10% of same and, if sewer charge is included on the same bill, if not paid a 10% penalty shall be added to it (if additional space is needed, attach pages the same size as this sheet, and number each.)

Water and sewer bills not paid within 15 days of the 30 day grace period for payment from billing will result in water being shut off. Water will only be turned on if all back water and sewer charges are paid and, if paid after 2:30 p.m. on a Village crew workday after shutoff; water will not be turned back on until the next weekday when the Village crew is working. An exception to the turnoff deadline shall be made and a member of the Village crew will be called out to turn on the water provided all back water and sewer charges are paid and the sum of \$100. is paid to the Village for a callout to turn the water back on after the above deadline.

E) Village bills for sewer and water are mailed on the first day of March, June, September and December and are due within 30 days of billing. No notice beyond one billing need be given. F) Town bills are mailed on the first day of February, May, August and November and are also due within 30 days from the first day of the month.

G) Seasonal fees to shutoff and turn water back on are \$50. each and shall be added to the bill. Notwithstanding a seasonal or periodic shutoff, line charges hereafter stated shall remain in force and not be added during such shutoff. H) Final read requests for transfers or sales shall be \$25. payable in advance with request. Section 2: The quarterly line charge for water meters now in effect is hereby amended based upon the line size at meter and shall be billed and payable as follows:

Line Size: Quarterly Line Fee:

up to 3/4 inch line at meter	\$30.
one inch line at meter	\$75.
1.50 inch line at meter	\$125.
2.00 inch line at meter	\$175.
3.00 inch line at meter	\$250.
4.00 inch line at meter	\$300.

Such line fees shall be imposed beginning with the next quarterly bill for water after the date of passage and filing hereof with the Department of State.

Section 3: This local law shall become effective on passage by this Board and filing with the NYS Department of State.


