A local law FIXING NEW SEWER RATES FOR PROPERTIES SERVED

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the

- as follows:

Section 1: Beginning with billing of June 1, 2019, the quarterly per unit rate of charge for properties connected with the Village of Mexico Sanitary Sewer System and located within the Village limits shall be \$131.5

SECTION 2: Beginning with the billing of June 1, 2019, the quarterly per unit rate of charge for units connected to and located outside the Village limits of the Village of Mexico shall be \$182.

SECTION 3: Sewer billings will be billed with water billings and any bill not paid within 30 days from date of billing shall also contain a 10% late charge.

SECTION 4: The property owner shall be ultimately responsible for payment of bills and bills unpaid as of May 15 of any year will be added to the appropriate tax bill next billed.

SECTION 5: This Local Law shall take effect upon passage and filing with the Department of State of the State of New York.
