A local law PROHIBITING USE OF WATER SERVICES OR FIRE HYDRANTS AND

PRESCRIBING PENALTIES THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the

- as follows:

I. Tampering with the Village of Mexico water system or a water system that is operated by the Village of Mexico or theft of service will be grounds for discontinuance of service and subject to the penalties hereafter set forth.

- II. Theft of service shall include but not be limited to the following:
- a) Opening valves at the curb or meter that have been turned off by the Village or by utility personnel;
 - b) Breaking, picking or damaging cut-off locks;
 - c) By-passing meters in any way;
 - d) Taking unmetered water from hydrants by anyone other than authorized official of a recognized fire department, fire insurance company or utility for any purpose other than firefighting, testing or flushing of hydrants;
 - e) Use of sprinkler system water for any purpose other than fire protection;
 - f) Removing, disabling or adjusting meter registers;
 - g) Connecting to or intentionally damaging water lines, valves or other appurtenances for the purpose stealing or damaging utility equipment;
 - h) Moving the meter or extending service without permission of the Village of Mexico Water Department or any other intentional act of defacement, destruction or vandalism to utility property that affects said property.

III. Penalties for unauthorized use of the Village of Mexico owned and or operated water systems, whether within or without the Village limits shall be as follows:

a) For a First Offense - \$1500.00 plus payment for the estimated water used at current rates in effect at the time of unauthorized use.

b) For a Second Offense - \$3,000.00 plus payment for the estimated water used at current rates in effect at the time of unauthorized usage;

c) A ten percent penalty will be assessed for all penalties not paid within fifteen days.

IV. This Local Law shall take effect after passage and immediately upon filing with the New York State Department of State.
