	SECTION 1: TITLE								
	This Local Law shall be known as Local Law No. 3 of 2021, a local law establishing new water rates by the Village of Mexico.								
	SECTION 2: PURPOSE								
	The purpose and intent of this law shall be to establish new water rates for the Village of Mexico, County of Oswego, State of New York as follows:								
	a	a. The quarterly water rate for water users inside the Village of Mexico shall be increased from \$3.00 per 1,000 gallons used to \$3.50 per 1,000 gallons used effective September 1, 2021.							
	b	increas	sed from \$3	ter rate for use 3.00 per 1,000 ber 1, 2021.	ers in the Town gallons used t	of New Haven shall be o \$3.50 per 1,000 gallor	e ns used		

- c. The quarterly water rates for the Town of Mexico shall be increased from \$3.00 per 1,000 gallons used to \$3.50 per 1,000 gallons used effective September 1, 2021.
- d. The quarterly water rates for the outside users tied into the Village of Mexico system shall be increased from \$4.45 per 1,000 gallons used to \$4.95 per 1,000 gallons used effective September 1, 2021.
- e. All water accounts inside or outside of the Village of Mexico shall remain in the property owner's name.

#### **SECTION 3: AUTHORITY**

This local law is enacted pursuant to the provisions of Section 4-412(1) of the Village Laws of the State of New York.

#### **SECTION 4: REPEALER:**

This local law shall supersede all prior local laws, ordinances, rules and regulations relative to water rates within the Village of Mexico and any prior such laws shall be, upon the effectiveness of this local law, null and void.

#### **SECTION 5: PROCEDURE FOR AMENDMENT**

The Village Board hereinafter can pass a resolution at any time to amend the water rate schedule for water use aforementioned in Section 2 of this local law.

### SECTION 6: EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect on September 1, 2021, upon the filing thereof in the Office of the Secretary of State.
