Supervisor Behling opened the regular Town Board meeting at 7:02 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Resolution 2023-36 Approval of Minutes

A motion was made by Councilor Greenway and seconded by Councilor Robert to approve the following resolution. The motion was adopted by a vote of 3 ayes: Behling, Partrick, and Robert, and 0 nays.

Resolution 2023-37 ZBA Resignation

Reports

Town Clerk/Water Clerk- A motion was made by Councilor Partrick and seconded by Councilor Robert to accept the March report as presented. The motion was adopted by a vote of 4 ayes: Behling, Greenway, Partrick, and Robert, and 0 nays.

Dog Control- Superintendent Behling read the report.

Community Park Manager- Mr. Diehl said the park is open and baseball and soccer are underway; more fence topper needs to be ordered; he thanked Councilor Robert's husband for brush-hog work. Diehl said there are some trees and stumps that need to be removed at an estimated cost of \$1,300. Councilor Robert said that two baseball fields are full of dog droppings. Robert will get locks for the fields and give Diehl and little league keys. Behling said that if the mess continues, the town's next step will be to not allow dogs at the Community Park.

Mexico Point Park- Chepko-Sade said the Earth Day cleanup went well; Casey's Cottage is open; requested someone install the changing tables in the bathhouse.

Planning Board- Chairwoman Weber remarked that the reports should be given verbally. Weber said the Planning Board heard the Cartier Application for a mini-storage facility and has passed it to the ZBA. Weber said the process/procedures that the boards go through to issue permits can be cumbersome and that a review of that law could help streamline the process for both boards and community members seeking special permits and variances. Weber said the Comprehensive Plan is in its draft form but that the town and village are hiring professionals to carry out the second phase of the plan, which includes surveys and analysis.

Zoning Board of Appeals- Chairman Waterbury said the meeting for the month has been moved to Wednesday and the public hearing for the Cartier application will take place the same time.

Water Commissioner- none

Supervisor- Behling said a solar company wanting to install a 1k acre farm to the East of the village has seemed to have withdrawn their interest.

A motion was made by Councilor Partrick and seconded by Councilor Robert to accept the May report as presented. The motion was adopted by a vote of 4 ayes: Behling, Partrick, Robert, Sharkey and 0 nays.

McAuslan Hall Update- Behling said work has stopped for the time being.

Behling said there is cost-share opportunity for the Assessor's certification and will add this to next month's agenda.

Seiter said that if a lawn mower is already in the town's highway budget, the board doesn't need to approve it again.

Brad Trudell said he has been appointed to the Village Zoning Board of Appeals and will be helping with the town's appeal for McAuslan Hall.

Resolution 2023-41 Tree Removal at Community Park

A motion was made by Councilor Robert and seconded by Councilor Sharkey to approve the following resolution. The motion was adopted by a vote of 4 ayes: Behling, Partrick, Robert, Sharkey, and 0 nays.

Resolved the Mexico Town Board approves the removal of trees and stumps at the Mexico Community Park not to exceed \$1,300.

Resolution 2023-42 Increase Lifeguard Pay

Resolved the Mexico Town Board approves the increase of lifeguard pay at Mexico Point Park to \$18 per hour for lifeguards and \$20 per hour for the head lifeguard.
