A visioning session took place Wednesday, September 18th, 2024 in Mexico at McAuslan Hall at 6:30pm. The purpose was to use community input to develop a vision for the future of Mexico and identify up to 10 goals that relates to the accomplishment of this vision.

During the meeting, community members were asked to participate in a VPS (Visual Preference Study), a community park design charette, and a "differences" conversation between a complete street vs its' current state.
