Weber would like the board to consider a vice chair to assist in running meetings. Loforte said she would fill in for Weber if she cannot be at a meeting.

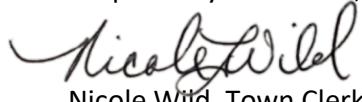
Weber said there is no other new business regarding the Ackerman Bakery on US RT 11 or the potential mine.
