REGULAR MEETING – 4:00 PM

The Village Board recognized Jeffery Marks for all his years of service and dedication to the Village of Mexico. Jeff has been an extreme asset to the village and will be missed. Jeff is retiring from the village effective October 9, 2024.

On motion of Trustee Hotchkiss, seconded Trustee Emery, all aye, the board agreed to pay off the BAN with Pathfinder Bank in the amount of \$51,532.10 for the water main repair crossing the Little Salmon River.

Kimberly Harter addressed the board in regards to the Black Creek dam removal and what this has done to the neighboring properties. John Power will address the concerns to the DEC and Fish and Wildlife. She also asked about trees being replanted throughout the village to replace ones that have been removed due to the water project.

After a lengthy discussion in regards to the status of Beck’s Hotel Mayor Grimshaw stated that he would reach out to Christal Watters to set up a meeting with the village board.

The meeting adjourned at 6:01 pm on motion of Trustee Harter, seconded Trustee Hotchkiss, all aye.
